



bReady Preparedness Analysis

Project Name: bReady Disaster/Emergency Preparedness Analysis

Grade Level: 9-12

All bReady lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of disaster and emergency preparedness.

Purpose: Students will learn about the various aspects of one specific disaster or emergency and how to prepare for it.

Materials needed: Computers (with Microsoft Word or PowerPoint), Internet, Library, etc

Duration: 2 Class periods

Instructions:

- Students should be split into even groups depending on the number of disasters or emergencies the teacher wishes to cover. Examples include: **Biological Threat, Blizzards, Chemical Threat, Earthquakes, Explosions, Extreme Heat, Fires, Floods, Influenza Pandemic, Landslides, Nuclear Threat, Radiation Threat, Thunderstorms, Wildfires, Winter Storms & Extreme Cold, etc.**
- The teacher should pick a specific disaster or emergency for each group to cover or have the groups pick their own.
- Students should be allowed time to research their topic and to organize a mini-report or PowerPoint to present to the class. The teacher can allow more or less time depending on how in depth he or she wishes the students to research.
- The students should include an overview of the disaster or emergency (what is it?), how to prepare for it, and what to do during the event.
