



bReady Show & Tell

Project Name: bReady Show & Tell

Grade Level: K - 2

All bReady lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of disaster and emergency preparedness.

Purpose: Students will learn the importance of creating an emergency and disaster preparedness kit and what items belong in a bReady kit. Students are exposed through their own presentation and the presentations of others

Materials Needed: None

Duration: 30 minutes (or however long show & tell usually lasts, depending on the number of students.)

Instructions:

- Teacher should establish the theme for the next show and tell as “bReady”.
- Students should bring in items that can be tied to emergency/disaster preparedness. It can be an item or a photo of an item that belongs in a bReady kit, something that represents a time when the student was prepared for an emergency or disaster, or a parent who is in the emergency/disaster field, etc.
- Students should present their item to the class and talk to the class about its relationship with emergency/disaster preparedness.
- When all of the students have presented the teacher should tie the activity together by stating the various types of emergency/disaster situations, how to be prepared, and the items necessary to create a bReady kit.
